SET UP TIMES

Friday, October 6, NOON to 6:00PM and/or Saturday, October 7, 6:30AM – 8:30AM NOTE: Booth borders & numbers will be marked with spray paint on the ground. Security is provided for Friday night. Vendors may park in the booth area to unload **only on FRIDAY**. Your parking area is on the grounds of the old rectory

house next door. On arrival please check in with the Vendor Area Chairperson.

There will be coffee and breakfast foods on sale early Saturday morning. The Food Booth offers lunch foods like hamburgers/hotdogs and barbeque plates.
