# II July Minutes/August Agenda

# III. Old/Ongoing Business

# A. Treasurer's Report: Michael

1. Michael went over income statement. He stated assets are in good shape. He plans to meet with Finance Committee soon.

### D. Rector's Ramblings: Ben

- 1. Masking in Worship: Keep asking churchgoers to wear their masks. Tasteful signs may be made stating mask protocol. Recommendation made to write in bulletin to wear mask during entire service in order to keep worshipping together in person.
- 2. Sound System in the Resurrection: Contract has been signed with Mississippi Sound. Funds have been budgeted for sound system. We are within the budget for the sound system.
- 3. Lectern will be ready in a few weeks. Cushions are delayed until September. Standing is fine at the altar rail. Pulpit will be around \$9,000-12,000 according to Bill. Ben has met with Buddy the decorator. He is working on the plaques and looking at rugs.
