- Approval of the July 2025 Minutes

 - Creating a Vestry Designated Fund
 - This fund would be separate from capital reserve account to be used at vestry's discretion
 - Motion to place \$14, 139 from capital reserves into a "Vestry Discretionary Fund" by Russell Wilcox, seconded by Martha Frye. Unanimous Approval.
 - Certificate of Deposit Renewal
 - CDR opened in 2024 with 12mo CD @ 4.5%
 - Bank offer to renew for 12mo @ 4%
 - Finance Committee recommends to renew at 4% along with the interest that has accrued.
 - Motion to renew CD and interest accrued at 4% for 12 mo made by Cliff Agnew and Seconded by Meredith Bailess; Unanimous approval.
 - \$5,000 for Concerts in the Country from ODR
 - Motion by Russ Markle to give \$5000 from capital reserves in ODR to pay for the Beloved Baroque Mississippi Symphony Concert in the Country; Marth Frye second; Unanimous approval.
